Vinification and Maturing

Mechanical harvesting at night in mid-September for Colombard and end of October for the Petit Manseng. Destemming. Cold skin-contact maceration for the Colombard from 8 to 15 hours. Progressive and gentle pressing then blending. The grape varieties are then fermented in new barrels. Aged in oak barrels for 8 months. Stirring of the lees for a better extraction of the richness and aromas. Filtration and bottling.

Tasting notes

Attitude has an attractive golden yellow colour. The nose is rich, expressive, with notes of exotic fruits (mango, pineapple) and sweet spices. On the palate, it is full-bodied and fresh wine. The finish is long, slightly oaky, buttered. It is a harmonious and balanced wine.

Food pairing

An opulent style that will go well with poultry in cream sauce, risotto with porcini mushrooms, grilled salmon, goat cheese...
